

Important Questions to Ask When Choosing an Abortion Provider

Making a pregnancy choice is a major decision and not one to be entered into lightly. Your body and your future are of the utmost importance. It's your right to have access to safe, reputable healthcare. These questions are designed to help you screen abortion providers to help ensure the clinic, physicians and other medical professionals are operating according to proper health and safety guidelines as well as gather the necessary information so you know there will be no unexpected expectations or payments. It's suggested that you gather the following information before moving forward in making an appointment.

1. What is the name of the physician performing the abortion?
2. Is he/she licensed and insured in your state?
3. What procedures are available to me in your clinic?
4. Will the procedures and risks be explained to me?
5. Will I be able to view an ultrasound and ask a physician questions before the procedure is performed?
6. What is the full cost of the procedure?
7. Will I receive any medication? If so, is there an extra cost?
8. Will I be awake during the procedure?
9. Is the procedure painful?
10. How long will I be at your facility on the day of the procedure?
11. What type of self care will be needed at home?
12. Will I be able to bring a support person with me to my appointment?
13. Can I go to work/school that day?
14. Will I need a follow up appointment? If so, is that included in the cost?
15. When is the money due for the procedure and what form of payment is accepted?
16. If payment is due before hand, what is your cancellation and refund policy?
17. If the pill does not result in a complete abortion, will I need to pay for a surgical procedure?
18. If complications occur, will the doctor at your clinic provide follow-up care?
19. If there is a significant complication with my surgical procedure what is the protocol?
20. If hospital care is needed, which hospital does the physician have privileges with?
